Our self-contained campuses provide housing, healing, workforce training, and long-term placement. We serve all three populations EO-2025 targets:

TRACK A:

ROADWAY REHABILITATION CAMPUSES

Municipal labor meets urgent housing needs.

- On-site transitional housing
- Mental health support and life skills
- Job training tied to city street, utility, and beautification contracts
- Direct contract fulfillment by trained residents

TRACK B:

MANUFACTURING + AUTO ASSEMBLY CAMPUSES

Private-sector employers save 40–60% on labor by working with HMIR.

- We build employer facilities on our campuses
- Residents are trained, stabilized, and placed into assembly, production, and logistics roles
- Ideal for auto plants, light manufacturing, packaging, and fulfillment
- Reduces turnover, absenteeism, and costs for employers
